1 INTRODUCTION TO THE APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process differs based on how you wish to be funded.

Self-supporting students apply directly through the university and have to pay an application fee of CNY 800 (for this option, see section 2)

Students who wish to apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS) have two options:

- They can apply for the **Chinese Government Scholarship through the Chinese embassy/consulate** in their own country. In this case, they are exempt from paying the application fee (for this option, see section 3) ;
- They can apply for the Chinese Government Scholarship through Renmin University. In this case, they have to pay the application fee (for this option, see section 4).

Furthermore, Chinese Government Scholarship students should complete two distinct applications: one for the Contemporary China Studies Program, and one for the scholarship. The table below offers a quick overview. For more details, check the following sections.

Students who wish to apply for **other scholarships** (see section 6.2 for Beijing Government Scholarship and Renmin University Outstanding Student Scholarship), can complete both the program application and the scholarship application on the same website. More details in the table below.








Upload required documents, submit your application, and pay the application fee.

6. FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

6.1 CHINESE GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Chinese Government Scholarship (CGS) is a funding program offered by the government of the People's Republic of China. It is managed by the China Scholarship Council (CSC).

This funding scheme varies for each scholarship type, but usually covers at least tuition or part of the tuition. Eligibility criteria and more details can be found on the CGS official website.

The CGS scheme has several programs. You may apply for more than one, but you can only be awarded one scholarship.

6.1.1 BILATERAL PROGRAM

This program is established by the Chinese government and the governments and institutions of other nations. To apply for this scholarship, you should contact the Chinese embassy or consulate in your home country and apply directly there.

To increase your chances to be admitted to the Contemporary China Studies Program with this scholarship, you may be asked to submit a pre-acceptance letter from us. In that case, you will need to first pass an admission interview (as outlined in section 3).

6.1.2 UNIVERSITY PROGRAM

This program is established directly though cooperation with Chinese universities (as outlined in section 4).

6.1.3 MOFCOM SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship scheme is sponsored by the Chinese Ministry of Commerce. More details can be found here.


6.1.4 OTHER CHINESE GOVERNMNET SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

These programs are set up through agreements between China and international organizations and institutions.

An applicant shall file an application with the international organizations and institutions concerned. Eligibility depends on nationality.

6.2.1 BEIJING MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The scholarship is given in the form of full or partial tuition refund. To apply, you should download the scholarship application form here, then upload it on the Renmin University application website. For more details, check here.

6.2.2 RENMIN UNIVERSITY OF CHINA OUTSTANDING INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS AWARD

The scholarship is a one-time award given after registration and payment of the tuition fee. The scholarship among is either CNY 20.000 or CNY 40.000. To apply, you should download the scholarship application form here, then upload it on the Renmin University application website. For more details, check here.
